2. Responsibilities

2.1 Club Committee / Management

- Ensure compliance with health and safety legislation.
- Appoint a Health and Safety Officer.
- Ensure risk assessments are conducted and reviewed regularly.
- Provide resources for training and safety equipment.

2.2 Health and Safety Officer

- Monitor health and safety performance.
- Ensure incidents and near misses are recorded and investigated.
- Organise health and safety training and briefings.
- Liaise with authorities as required.

2.3 Employees

- Take care of their own health and safety and that of others.
- Report hazards, near misses, and accidents promptly.

• Use equipment and protective gear properly.

2.4 Members and Visitors

- Comply with club safety signage and rules.
- Report hazards to staff immediately.
- Respect course closures and maintenance operations.

3. Risk Assessment

The club conducts routine risk assessments covering:

- Course hazards (e.g., flying golf balls, weather, uneven terrain)
- Machinery (e.g., mowers, buggies, maintenance equipment)
- Chemicals (e.g., fertilizers, pesticides COSHH assessments required)
- Clubhouse facilities (e.g., kitchens, bars, stairs)
- Manual handling
- Slips, trips and falls

Risk assessments are reviewed annually or after incidents.

4. Safe Working Procedures

We have documented and implemented safe systems of work for:

- Operating groundskeeping machinery
- Storing and handling chemicals (COSHH)
- Fire safety procedures
- First aid provision
- Electrical safety checks
- Food hygiene (if food and drink are served)

5. Emergency Procedures

- First aid kits are located at The Clubhouse, Green Keeper Compound
- Trained first aiders: Matthew Pritchard, Anthony Woosey
- Emergency contact numbers displayed throughout the club.
- Fire alarms and extinguishers are installed and regularly checked.
- Fire evacuation routes clearly marked and drilled annually.

6. Training and Communication

- Induction training for all new staff.
- Annual safety refresher training.
- Toolbox talks for grounds staff.
- Safety information made available to members and visitors.

7. Accident Reporting

- All accidents and near-misses must be reported and recorded in the accident book (held at The Clubhouse).
- Serious incidents are reported under RIDDOR regulations.
- Investigations will be conducted to prevent recurrence.

8. Review and Monitoring

This policy will be reviewed annually or after a significant change in operations, accident, or legislation.
